

RULES FOR AWARDING TITLES & TITLE UPDATES



1. Champion, Grand Champion and Double Grand Champion titles for Neuter Cats and Spay Cats require a minimum of 10 awards of merit per title update.
2. Bronze Double Grand Champion, Silver Double Grand Champion and Gold Double Grand Champion titles for all cats require a minimum of 15 awards of merit per title update.
3. Award of merit cards submitted for these title updates must be in date and show sequence.
4. Awards of merits won at shows conducted by Clubs of Governing Bodies that are affiliated with The Australian Cat Federation Inc., or Clubs of any other recognised Governing Body are acceptable.
5. Application for all titles must include a majority of merits gained at CATS NSW Inc. affiliated shows and/or ACF or CCCA National Cat Shows. All merits will be recognised from Multi-Ring Shows.
6. Any Championship or higher status title won Interstate will only be recognised upon verification of the title. Forms can be obtained from the Registrar.
7. All awards of merit obtained from an ACF National Show will be recognised and are not subject to Rule 5.
8. Order of title preceding cat's name will be Cats NSW title, followed by any other ACF governing body title, followed by NSW CFA, etc....
