RULES FOR AWARDING TITLES & TITLE UPDATES



1. Champion, Grand Champion and Double Grand Champion titles for Male Cats require a minimum of 70 points and Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats require a minimum of 60 points per title update.
2. Bronze Double Grand Champion, Silver Double Grand Champion and Gold Double Grand Champion titles for all cats require a minimum of 100 points per title update.
3. Challenge award cards submitted for these title updates must be in date and show sequence.
4. Award points may be carried forward from one title to the next. Carry over points will be indicated on the most recent challenge certificate submitted with an application and that challenge certificate must be resubmitted with the next title update application to verify the carrying over of points.
5. Challenges won at shows conducted by Clubs of Governing Bodies that are affiliated with The Australian Cat Federation Inc., or Clubs of any other recognised Governing Body are acceptable PROVIDED that there is a compulsory open class.
6. Application for all titles must include a majority of challenge points gained at CATS NSW Inc. affiliated shows and/or ACF or CCCA National Cat Shows. All challenges will be recognised from Multi-Ring Shows.
7. Challenges won at shows conducted by Clubs outside NSW which do NOT specify points awarded must be submitted with a "Recognition of Challenge" form signed by the Show Secretary or Show Manager of the Club concerned.
8. If a cat is desexed or is subject to a colour change after gaining a title all titles gained will be carried over.
9. Any Championship or higher status title won Interstate or Overseas will only be recognised upon verification of the title. Forms can be obtained from the Registrar.
10. All Challenges obtained from an ACF National Show will be recognised and are not subject to Rule 6.
11. Order of title preceding cat's name will be ACF title followed by Cats NSW title, followed by any other ACF governing body title, followed by CCCA, followed by NSW CFA, etc....
