**RULES FOR AWARDING HIGHER UPDATES** 

(Rules updated 02/07/2023)

1	These higher titles are for Male Cats, Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats reaching Gold Double Grand Championship status
2	Platinum, Sapphire, Ruby, Emerald & Diamond awards for all cats require 10 x 20 Point Challenges per title update
3	Only 20 Point Challenge award cards dated after the cat has obtained Gold Double Grand Champion may be submitted to obtain a higher title
4	20 Point Challenge award cards submitted for these awards must be in date and show sequence
5	20 Point Challenges won at shows conducted by Clubs of Governing Bodies that are affiliated with The Australian Cat Federation Inc., or Clubs of any other recognised Governing Body are acceptable PROVIDED that there is a compulsory open class
6	Application for all titles must include a majority of 20 Point challenges gained at CATS NSW Inc. affiliated shows and/or ACF or CCCA National Shows. All 20 Point challenges will be recognised from Multi-Ring Shows. Members who reside more than 400km from Sydney GPO are able to include challenges from interstate ACF bodies in their majority of challenges
7	20 Point Challenges won at shows conducted by Clubs outside NSW which do NOT specify points awarded must be submitted with a "Recognition of Challenge" form signed by the Show Secretary or Show Manager of the Club concerned
8	If a cat is de-sexed or is subject to a colour change after gaining a title, all titles gained will be carried over
9	Any higher status title won Interstate or Overseas will only be recognised upon verification of the title. Forms can be obtained from the Registrar
10	Order of title preceding cat's name will be the ACF title followed by the Cats NSW title, or any other ACF governing body title, followed by CCCA, followed by NSW CFA, etc
