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Rules for awarding Titles and Title Updates

(Form Updated 16/1/2025)

1	These higher status titles are for Male Cats, Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats who have reached Gold Double Grand Champion.
2	Platinum, Sapphire, Ruby, Emerald & Diamond awards require 10 x 20 point challenge cards/certificates per title for all cats.
3	Only Challenge cards/certificates that are dated after the cat has obtained Gold Double Grand Champion may be submitted to obtain higher status title.
4	Original challenge cards/certificates are to be submitted in date and show sequence
5	Challenges won at shows conducted by clubs of Governing Bodies that are affiliated with The Australian Cat Federation Inc, or clubs are acceptable PROVIDED that there is a compulsory open class.
6	Application for titles must include a majority of challenges gained at Cats NSW, Cats NSW Affiliated Clubs or ACF or CCCA National shows. <i>Members who reside more than 200km radius from Sydney GPO can include challenges from interstate ACF bodies and intrastate CCCA shows in their majority of challenges</i>
7	Challenges won at shows conducted by shows outside NSW that DO NOT specify points awarded must be submitted with a "Recognition of Challenge" for signed by the show secretary of show manager of the club concerned.
8	If a cat is desexed or subject to a colour change after gaining a title all titles will be carried over.
9	Order of title preceding cats name will be ACF Titles followed by Cats NSW titles followed by other ACF Governing body titles followed by CCCA, followed by any other governing body titles
