

## Exhibitors Please Note - Conditions of Entry

- 1) All Entries must be made on the official NSW CFA Entry Form together with a clear copy of each exhibit's registration certificate in the name of the exhibitor as owner. Forms are available from the NSW CFA Website (download from: [www.hotkey.net.au/~nswcfa/download.htm](http://www.hotkey.net.au/~nswcfa/download.htm)), the Office or attached to this schedule.  
For interstate exhibitors where the registration certificate does not include four generations, then the application for entry must be accompanied by a copy of the exhibit's pedigree showing four (4) generations with appropriate breeds and colours of all forebears. (Show Procedure 5.4)
- 2) All exhibits must have both front and back claws clipped. (S.P. 6.5)
- 3) Entry fees for all cats and kittens cover three rings.
- 4) Cats should be entered in at least one open ring.
- 5) All kittens other than litter kittens should be entered in their age class in at least one ring.
- 6) There will be no reduction in entry fees if a cat / kitten is entered in only one or two rings.
- 7) All kittens must have a current vaccination certificate with the first inoculation dated no less than 2 weeks prior to the Show date. Without this, your kitten(s) will not be allowed into the Show. (S.P. 6.3)
- 8) Only wood based or paper litter to be used in the hall.
- 9) All cats/kittens must remain on show until 4.00 pm.
- 10) All male cats will be benched together.
- 11) Exhibitors are reminded that a Judge or Steward does not have to handle any exhibit showing signs of aggression. Owners have a duty of care not to bench exhibits with a reported history of fractious behaviour. Show Managers and the Show Committee, in consultation with the Show Representative, has the right to require the removal of the latter exhibits from the show.
- 12) To be eligible for showing, a Companion Cat exhibit must be desexed. Companion Kitten exhibits over the age of 6 months must be desexed". (as per Show Procedure 3.9)  
For an unregistered companion exhibit, where applicable, a copy of the exhibit's certificate of sterilization (desexing) signed by a qualified veterinary surgeon must accompany the entry.
- 13) Amendments to Sex/Color/titles: Any change to the sex, color/pattern or title of an exhibit after an entry has been lodged must be submitted in writing to the Show Secretary together with a copy of the amended Certificate of Registration. (S.P. 5.11)
- 14) All exhibitors resident in NSW must be current financial members of NSWCFA, TFA of NSW or ANCATS.
- 15) When the Management Committee has approved a show to be an Open Entry Show then members of TFA of NSW and ANCATS are eligible to enter that show, and their exhibits must comply with CCCA Breed Standards. ANCATS pedigrees must also be verified by the NSW CFA office. (S.P. 1.7)

CCCA Award Classes: Eligible titled cats will be automatically entered in their relevant class.

Incorrect entry:	The show secretary reserves the right to transfer exhibits that are not correctly entered.
Cancellations:	To save space and work in erecting unnecessary cages, we ask that all cancellations be phoned to the Show Secretary, <b>Val Hurry on 02 4271 1688</b> by Thursday 5 <sup>th</sup> Sept 2013.
Returned cheques:	Should any cheque be returned to the exhibitor unpaid, a money order, cash or bank cheque will be required immediately to ensure that the entry is processed. The exhibitor will pay any cost incurred by the club owing to returned cheques.
Entry fees:	<b>Please note entries will be returned unless accompanied by full payment of fees as per NSW CFA show procedures (5.13). If this occurs, an administration fee of \$2 will be required before acceptance of entry.</b>
Ribbons/prizes etc.	An ribbons, prizes, rosettes and cards etc placed on the cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and will not be replaced should they go missing.

## Other Necessary Information (Cont)

### NSWCFA Inc Members and Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Awards

A cat/kitten may accumulate points for a Members or Associate Members Cat/Kitten of the Year Award only whilst it is in the continuous ownership of a financial member of the NSW CFA Inc.

Note that:

- (i) Should an owner become a member of NSW CFA after commencement of the calendar year (ie after 1 January), a cat/kitten owned by the new member will be eligible for the awards but **points** will accumulate only from the date that the membership application is processed by the NSW CFA's office.
- (ii) If during the year ownership of a cat/kitten is transferred from a financial member to a new owner who is not a member, the cat/kitten's ownership by a financial member will be deemed to be continuous provided a membership application from the new owner is received by the NSW CFA's office within 4 (four) weeks of the transfer as recorded by the NSW CFA.
- (iii) There will be an Associate Members Award for Best Kitten, Best Entire Cat and Best Desexed cat in Group 1, Group 2 and Group 3, with an Award for Best Kitten and Best Cat in the Companion Exhibits with each Award based on normal Top Five placing points.

## Special Notice


An exhibitor resident in NSW must be a current financial member of NSW CFA Inc. However, a new exhibitor resident in NSW may show 3 times as a non-member provided any pedigree exhibits(s) shown is/are registered in the exhibitor's name with NSW CFA. An exhibitor resident in another state/territory/country must be a member of a recognised controlling body in that state/territory/country and the exhibit(s) entered registered in the exhibitor's name with that controlling body. (Show Procedure 1.7)



## Lucky Eight Judge – Maureen Norberry (NSWCFA)

All Group 1, 2 & 3 cat and kitten exhibits will be entered at NO charge.

- ❖ Each of eight (8) contestants to be drawn from all Group 1, 2 & 3 exhibits entered in Show with the exception of all the 1<sup>st</sup> Top 5 winners in each Group. That is, qualifying for the event is nothing other than being in attendance at the Show and not being 1<sup>st</sup> Top 5.
- ❖ The first cat/kitten drawn will be judged against the second, with the winner going into round 2. The third cat/kitten drawn will be judged against the fourth, with the winner going into round 2 etc. The winner of 1 v 2 and 3 v 4 will be judged against each other, with the winner going into the finals against the winner of the alternate side of the competition.



- ❖ Competitors selected for the first round receive a prize with, the last exhibit remaining being declared the winner and will be awarded the Major Lucky 8 Prize.
- ❖ Note : The above is intended to be a FUN event and in no way is meant to contravene the rules and show procedures of the NSW CFA Inc.

## Reminder: COMPANION KITTENS/CATS

To be eligible for showing, a Companion Cat exhibit must be desexed. Companion Kitten exhibits over the age of 6 months must be desexed". (as per Show Procedure 3.9)

For an unregistered companion exhibit, where applicable, a copy of the exhibit's certificate of sterilization (desexing) signed by a qualified veterinary surgeon must accompany the entry.

**Kitten** = over 10 weeks of age and under 9 months of age

**Cat** = 9 months of age and over

To compete in a show run under NSW C.F.A Inc Rules and Show procedures, a Companion Exhibit needs to be classified as to:

### \*TYPE

**Domestic** ( a kitten/cat whose sire & dam are unknown or are both not registered pedigree cats) or **Household Pet** ( a kitten/cat whose sire or dam unknown but not both is registered, or is a pedigree cat which is unregistrable)

**Domestic** kittens/cats need to be classified as to:

\***COAT PATTERN:** \* **Solid**, \***Patterned**, or \* **Patched**

**NOTE:** Each Companion exhibit entered in a Show for the first time will be classified before judging commences. The classifying panel of judges will complete the Classification Section of a NSW C.F.A. Inc Companion Exhibit Classification /Registration Form and the original of the form will be given to the owner of the exhibit. A Companion Exhibit may be shown only 3 times without being registered with NSW C.F.A. Inc.
