

Group 1 – Longhair – includes: Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian & Turkish Van.

Group 2 – Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald, Siamese;

Group 3 – Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, British Shorthair, Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Longhair, La Perm Shorthair, Manx, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese

Group 4 – Companion Pets Longhair, Companion Pets Shorthair

Groups 1, 2, 3 are divided into three main classes: Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten.

Group 4 two main classes: Desexed Cat & Kitten (please note all kittens over six months of age must be desexed).

Awards

Challenges: All females, males, neuters & spays will compete in open classes by breed and colour

ACF Awards: (where merited) will be awarded in all rings to the best placed exhibit Male, Female, Neuter, Spay in Groups 1, 2 & 3. The Exhibit must be placed in the top 5 to be considered for this award.


Where the judge feels the quality of the exhibits merit such awards, ribbons and/or product will be awarded in each ring to the Top 5 Entire Cats, Top 5 Desexed Cats, Top 5 Kittens in Groups 1, 2 & 3. Top 5 Companion Cats & Top 5 Companion Kittens will be awarded in Group 4

Supreme Exhibit in Show.

All exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year points.

Cats NSW Inc. representatives & officiating judges reserve the right without prejudice, to expel any exhibit from the show that appears to be in ill health or condition (including the presence of external parasites). Such decisions are final



Conditions of Entry

These rules govern all shows held by Cats NSW Inc. or its affiliate clubs. All shows are conducted under the rules of Cats NSW Inc. and the show committee reserves the right to reject an entry without explanation. All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits, but Cats NSW Inc., its affiliate clubs, or their officials, accept no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury to any feline or exhibitor's property at the show.

All pedigree exhibits hold registration recognised by Cats NSW Inc. A copy of the registered Pedigree (minimum four generations) must accompany the entry form for each pedigree exhibit entered. All entries must be forwarded on the prescribed form/s to ensure acceptance, and all forms must be complete. Incomplete forms will be returned to the exhibitor. All entries must be accompanied by payment in full, or evidence of payment via Direct Deposit.

Returned Cheques: Should any cheque be returned unpaid, a bank cheque or money order will be required to ensure that the entry is processed, and the costs incurred by the club for the returned cheque shall be paid by the exhibitor.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc.

A Vet may be present on the day to inspect all exhibits. He/she will be empowered to disqualify all exhibits, which in their opinion are suffering from any infectious or contagious disease or are not in show condition. The Vet's decision is final. If any exhibit is rejected because of an infectious or contagious disease they will disqualify all the other exhibits from the same cattery.

If a Vet is not present or has left the hall, then a Vetting-In committee comprising of at least two Cats NSW Inc members will be appointed to check exhibits on the day and request the removal of any exhibit they feel is not in show condition. Cats obviously in kitten will not be judged. No kitten under the age of 12 weeks will be allowed entry to the venue. Lactating queens shall not be benched without their litters.

Vaccination certificates: All kittens must be vaccinated. Exhibitors must produce documentary evidence (valid vaccination certificate) for each kitten and a vaccination shall have been carried out not less than 14 days prior to the date of the show. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of the exhibit concerned.

ALL EXHIBITS MUST HAVE ALL THEIR CLAWS CLIPPED PRIOR TO ENTRY TO THE SHOW HALL.

A judge is empowered to withhold any award in any class if in his/her opinion the exhibit does not possess sufficient merit. Any protests can be made to the show committee, in writing, accompanied by a \$20 fee within seven days after the show. A judge may not judge an exhibit that has been domiciled at their home during the preceding three months.

An open challenge system is used. All entire/altered cats will compete in their own category within their own breed. Challenges can be used in any status section. All Companion Pets over the age of six months must be desexed.

NO EXHIBIT MAY BE REMOVED FROM THE HALL PRIOR TO THE CONCLUSION OF THE SHOW WITHOUT THE PERMISSION OF THE SHOW MANAGER OR MEMBER OF THE SHOW COMMITTEE.

Difficult to handle Cats: If, at any time an exhibit shows itself to be difficult to handle or threatening, the Judge may call for the owner to remove the exhibit from its cage and place it on the Judge's table. The Judge will then decide if she/he wishes to judge that animal. This procedure protects your cat from any unnecessary handling. Should your exhibit be marked "Unable to be Judged" then it is automatically withdrawn from any other rings and cannot be shown again on the day. Should the judge consider the exhibit TO BE OF POOR TEMPERAMENT or in their opinion sufficiently difficult to handle, including excessively timid, the judge may withhold any awards at their discretion.

Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. The comfort of all exhibitors and judges is of paramount importance. One warning will be issued and if any further offences occur the exhibitor and their exhibits will be asked to leave the show.

An entrance fee may be payable by all members of the general public i.e. not an exhibitor or invited guest of Cats NSW Inc. If a member of the general public is deemed to be acting in a disruptive manner, that individual will be required by the Show Representative, to leave the show immediately. Cats NSW Inc. reserves the right to refuse entry to any member of the general public they feel may cause discomfort to their exhibitors.

Awards and prizes: All such cards, trophies placed on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and the Club regrets that it is not possible to replace any that may subsequently disappear from unattended cages. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary the prize list if necessary.

- ❖ Exhibits will not be charged an Entry Fee
- ❖ Exhibits will be judged in Ring 1 only
- ❖ A maximum of 12 exhibits is allowed.
- ❖ Theresa Johnson has been appointed to this assignment & she will judge to the specified ACF Standards.
- ❖ Judging Slip will be completed & forwarded to Cats NSW. Details will include contestants & appropriate placings.
- ❖ This event will not see exhibits compete against Companion exhibits nor compete for Cat of the Year
- ❖ Show Officials will be assigned to the management of this event.
- ❖ NO exhibits will be permitted to rehome on the day of the show.




