

JUDGES

Thea Lamprecht (WCF South Africa)



Thea has been a member of the cat fancy in South Africa for

more than 30 years and has been breeding different breeds of short haired cats for more than 3 decades together with her husband Johan. She has been involved with WCF and Independent cat show organising and administration for many years and more recently with pupil judges' training, examinations and workshops.

During her years of training she trained at cat shows in Dubai, Brazil, France, Russia, Denmark, Czech Republic, Poland, Slovakia and Malta (in WCF, FIFE, LOOF and Independent shows) apart from exposure to cat shows in the South African provinces of Western Cape, Northern Cape, Eastern Cape, Gauteng and Kwazulu Natal. Thea qualified as a World Cat Federation (WCF) All Breeds Judge in June 2014. She was the first WCF qualified All Breeds judge in Africa and in South Africa. She also holds an Independent Judges licence for the Cat Judges Guild of Africa (CJGA) and since 2015 she is a Cat Federation of South Africa (CFSA) guest judge.

She has judged internationally for WCF, LOOF, Independent and other cat federations in Malta, Russia, Belarus, France, Holland, India, Australia, New Zealand, China, Thailand, Poland, Lithuania and Germany including several World Shows. She regularly judges at cat shows in the above mentioned provinces in South Africa for WCF, Independent and CFSA clubs. International judging invitations for 2018 included Perth and Adelaide in Australia as well as for China and Thailand.

She became a Hills Science Diet Ambassador in 2015 upon invitation, has done and passed a feline and canine nutrition examination and regularly attends feline and canine nutrition workshops and symposia.

She is busy with her PhD in music education at the University of Stellenbosch. Her two children study at the University of Stellenbosch – Gernes studies Philosophy and Psychology and Julia studies Law. She is married to Dr. Johan Lamprecht, President of CASA/ WCF in South Africa and

Second Vice President of the WCF board internationally. They live on a small holding in Durbanville, Western Cape, with their cats, two dogs and one bunny.

Dr. Johan Lamprecht (WCF South Africa)



My first non pedigreed cat was a Black Bicolour shorthair stray female fed secretly on the windowsill of my bedroom as a child. (I was not allowed to keep a cat or a dog, due to family allergies and dad's opinion that they did not produce anything and one could not breed them!). My second non pedigreed cat was a Sealpoint Siamese female from a local pet shop. "Meraai" shared our commune flat during student days.

My first pedigreed cat was a Lilacpoint Siamese male, bought from an advert in the paper, he also shared our student digs. I started breeding Siamese in 1984. Cattery name: Les Beaux Chats (Registered SACC)

Current breeds - Siamese, Oriental, Balinese, Oriental Medium hair, Cornish Rex, British Shorthair (Colourpoint), Manx, Munchkin, LaPerm, Japanese Bobtail and Sphynx. Some are breeding cats, some show cats and many merely pets. Bred several Champions/Premiers, Grand Champions/Premiers and Supreme Champions/Premiers as well as bred and owned some Regional and National "Top Twenty" contestants for South African Cat of the Year and Neuter of the Year. Breeder and owner of the SACC CAT OF THE YEAR - 2000 (Sup Ch Les Beaux Chats Rexotic - Cornish Rex).

I have been a member of the All Breeds Cat Club (Cape Town) since 1982, committee member since 1984 and chairman for more than 10 years. Other positions on the committee: Newsletter editor, Governing Council Delegate, Show Manager, Membership Secretary, Vice Chairman.

I have been a member of the Governing Council of SACC (formerly the GCC of ACC of SA) for more than 10 years. Positions on Council include: All Breeds Cat Club delegate, Siamese/Oriental Breed Council Delegate, Vice Chairman, Genetics Advisor to the Registrar, International Liaison Officer.

I first qualified as Siamese/Oriental Judge in 1990. Qualified as All Breeds Judge four years later (1994), having completed all the formal courses and examinations for the other breed groups.

Affiliations:

The Cape Panel of Cat Judges, affiliated to The South African Council of Cat Judges, in turn affiliated to the Southern African Cat Council (Formerly known as The Governing Council of the Associated Cat Clubs of South Africa) - the original cat registering body in South Africa with clubs existing since the 1940s.

The French/European Independent Cat Clubs, including SCFF, officially recognized by the French Government (L.O.O.F.), registered as an Independent All Breeds Judge.

Janice Davey (NZCF)

I'm a cat lover from way back.

In 1987, with my husband John, we started breeding Birmans under the prefix LEEGRGO. Then we went on to breed Tabby Birman with the prefix BIRPUR. We have had some excellent show moments with Father/ Son/ and Grandson winning the National Show and also two of these cats have been Longhair Cat of the Year.

I am a member of The Sacred Temple Cat Club of New Zealand and I am a Life member. I have held position of Club President, Secretary and show Secretary.

My Judges training started in 1999, I became a Senior Longhair Judge in 2003, then an All Breeds Judge in 2013. I am also an All Breeds Tutor Judge.

I really enjoy the judging scene, meeting the exhibitors of these beautiful cats, talking to breeders about their breeds, every time I am out on the floor it is very rewarding. I have judged in most of the Australian States and New Zealand.

ABYSSINIAN/SOMALI AWARDS

NOTE

At this show, Abyssinian and Somali exhibitors have the choice of entering their exhibits in the three all breed rings (Rings 1, 2 & 3) as well as the two specialist rings (Rings 4 & 5) for \$50 for each exhibit

OR

they may opt for entering Rings 1, 4 & 5 ONLY if they feel this is more suitable for a particular exhibit at a cost of \$35 per exhibit.

*Rings 1, 4 & 5 will be used to determine the Abyssinian and Somali Awards for the Show.

AWARDS SYSTEM FOR ABY/SOMALI AWARDS: RINGS 1, 4 & 5

The following system will be used to determine the Supreme winners: Supreme Kitten will be the kitten who scores the most points overall in the Top 10 Aby/Somali kitten rings (Rings 4 & 5) as well as from Ring 1 Top 5 Group 3 Kittens. In Rings 4 & 5, 10 points will be awarded to the best kitten in a ring, 9 points to the second kitten, 8 points to the third kitten, and so on down to one point for the 10th kitten. In Ring 1, 10 points will be awarded to the highest placing Aby/Somali kitten in the ring, 9 points to the second highest placing Aby/Somali kitten, and so on. The runner-up in each case will be the kitten scoring the second-highest number of points. The same scheme will be used for Supreme Cat (entire) and Supreme Desexed Cat. Supreme Exhibit will follow the same system using the Top Aby/Somali Exhibit categories in Rings 1, 4 & 5. Note: Supreme Exhibit does not have to be awarded Top Exhibit in a Ring to qualify for the award.

Most Successful Breeder in Show will be determined by adding up all points gained by kittens, cats and desexed cats bred by that breeder, in the three Top 10 Aby/Somali Exhibit rings (Rings 1, 4 & 5), with 10 points for 1st, 9 points for 2nd and so on, as in the Supreme points system.





FIVE DAY SHOW RULE....An exhibit shall not be exhibited at a show until at least five (5) clear days have passed since the last day of the preceding show at which it was exhibited.

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1 Aphrodite Longhair, Aphrodite Shorthair, Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian Turkish Angora & Turkish Van.
- Group 2 Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald, and Siamese
- Group 3 Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bombay, British Shorthair, Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Longhair, La Perm Shorthair, Mandalay, Manx, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese
- Group 4 Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 12 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion

ACF Award of Excellent maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay Cat in Groups 1, 2 & 3 in all rings.

Group 4 are divided into 2 main classes, Desexed Cat and Desexed Kitten. An Award of Merit maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Companion Neuter Cat and Companion Spay Cat in all rings. The exhibit must be placed in the Top 5 to be considered for this award.

Where the Judge feels the quality of the exhibits merit such awards, ribbons and/or product will be awarded in each ring to the Top 10 Entire Cats, Top 10 Desexed Cats, Top 10 Kittens in Groups 1, 2 and 3, and Top 5 Companions in Group 4.

A Supreme Exhibit in Show in each ring will be awarded. Companion exhibits are not eligible for this award

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards

Cats NSW Inc. representatives and officiating judges reserve the right without prejudice, to expel any exhibit from the show that appears to be in ill health or condition (including the presence of external parasites). Such decisions are final.

All entries must be completed in full on the Cats NSW Show Entry and Benching Slip and the show entry summary sheet that form part of the show schedule. All completed entries must be forwarded to the address as nominated in the show schedule. The show committee reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation.

For each exhibit, a legible photocopy or electronic copy of its current Certificate of Registration must accompany the show entry. The Certificate of Registration must be in the name of the exhibitor and be issued by that person's governing body. Incomplete entries will be returned to the exhibitor. All exhibit's Certificates of Registration must be issued by the Governing Body to which the exhibitor is a member.

Kittens under the age of 4 months are permitted to be entered with "REGISTRATION PENDING" by ACF Breeder affiliates and Cats NSW Inc. members and that have submitted a registration application only. Entries must be submitted on the "REGISTRATION PENDING" entry form (see below).

Female cats obviously in kitten will not be judged. No kitten under the age of 12 weeks will be allowed entry to the venue. The age of each exhibit will be calculated to be the actual age on the day of the show or the first day of a multi-day show. Lactating queens shall not be benched without their litters.

KITTEN - NEW VACCINATION RECOMMENDATION Each kitten exhibit must have had at least one (1) Feline 3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show. Documentary evidence i.e. a valid vaccination certificate from a Veterinarian must be submitted with entry. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of exhibits entry.

It is highly recommended that all kittens have at least their 2nd vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show due to the recent outbreak of Feline Panleukopenia Virus (FPV) in New South Wales

ADULT - NEW VACCINATION RULES APPLY - Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The vaccination certificate must indicate a valid vaccination being administered no more than 3 years prior to the show. A copy of the vaccination certificate must be provided with entry.

A Veterinarian or Veterinarian Nurse will be present at all Cats NSW shows. All exhibits entered in show including those on exhibition must be examined by a Vet, Vet Nurse or an appointed Steward before being benched into the show cages.

The Veterinarian shall disqualify any exhibit, which in their opinion is showing symptoms of any contagious disease or not be in show condition. The Vet's decision is final. If any exhibit is rejected because of an infectious or contagious disease they will disqualify all the other exhibits from the same cattery.

If a Vet is not present or has left the hall the Show Manager shall appoint two accredited stewards to check on exhibits and request the removal of any exhibit that is deemed not to be in show condition. All exhibits must have all their claws clipped prior to entry to the show hall and must be brought to the show confined in an appropriate container.

Exhibits cannot be removed from the Show or from the cage designated by the Show personnel without the consent of the Show Manager. All exhibits must remain in the venue until the conclusion of the show at the advertised time

If, at any time an exhibit shows itself to be difficult to handle or threatening, the Judge may call for the owner to remove the exhibit from its cage and place it on the Judge's table. The Judge will then decide if she/he wishes to judge that animal. This procedure protects your cat from any unnecessary handling. Should your exhibit be marked "Unable to be Judged" then it is automatically withdrawn from any other rings and cannot be shown again on the day. Should the judge consider the exhibit to be of poor temperament or in their opinion sufficiently difficult to handle, including excessively timid, the judge may withhold any awards at their discretion.

Poor sportsmanship will not be tolerated. The comfort of all exhibitors and judges is of paramount importance. One warning will be issued and if any further offences occur the exhibitor and their exhibits will be asked to leave the show.

An entrance fee may be payable by all members of the general public i.e. not an exhibitor or invited guest of Cats NSW Inc. If a member of the general public is deemed to be acting in a disruptive manner, that individual will be required by the Show Representative, to leave the show immediately. Cats NSW Inc. reserves the right to refuse entry to any member of the general public they feel may cause discomfort to their exhibitors.

Awards and prizes: All such cards, trophies placed on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and the Club regrets that it is not possible to replace any that may subsequently disappear from unattended cages. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary the prize list if necessary.

All complaints regarding a show must be submitted in writing and be accompanied by a fee of twenty dollars (\$20). All complaints must be in the hands of the Show Manager or Show Secretary within seven (7) days following the Show. Complaints regarding the running of a Show will be not be considered by Cats NSW unless lodged in accordance with this rule.

All reasonable care will be taken of exhibits. Cats NSW and its affiliate Clubs, their officials and members cannot accept any responsibility for any loss or damage to any person, feline or property.
