My first purebred cat was a wonderful seal point Siamese but after a visit to a cat show I fell in love with the Burmese, purchased my first breeding girl and registered my Zarlee prefix the same year, while still a teenager.

I exhibited and bred Burmese of all colours, winning Best in Show a number of times for 10 years, however it was during this time I saw my first Birman cat at Sydney Town Hall cat show and I was hooked!

So it was in 1982 that a seal point Birman joined my family, followed by a number of imports (UK, Sweden, NZ) for my passion of chocolate cats

I started breeding Colourpoints about 20 years ago under the OZKI Prefix with Linda. We then moved on to Persians and Exotic tabbies, bi-colours, chocolates and vans with success. I was invited to become a Group 1 judge which I completed in 2010. I have enjoyed judging at the CCCA National in Queensland and shows throughout Queensland, New South Wales, Victoria and New Zealand. We imported the American Shorthair breed into Australia in mid 2012 and have been breeding and showing our black silver classic tabbies with great success. I am currently undergoing a Shorthair Course. I have thoroughly enjoyed handling many beautiful exhibits and I have had the pleasure of meeting many exhibitors across the country.

I achieved Best in Show awards with my Birmans both here and with exports.

It was during one of my trips to the continent that I discovered the beauty of the Fife Oriental.

In 2011 I added the most divine Hungarian bi-colour Oriental to my home and you guessed it, a chocolate and white. Then followed a beautiful Austrian black tabby and white Oriental girl plus a locally grown tabby point Siamese. I went full circle. All are now retired pets and much loved companions

I became a CCCA judge in 1999 (G1), G2 in 2003 and finished to All Breed in 2010. I am a Life member of the Birman Cat Club of Australasia Inc after serving as President and Show Manager for over a decade.

I have been an active Cat Fancy member, presented at many CCCA Judges Conferences, and Chaired a G1 Judges Training course for NSWCFCA, sat on Breed Standard Committees as well as an Association committee and President.

I consider myself fortunate to have judged around most of Australia and New Zealand as well as in France, Belgium and Netherlands. In this time I have been privileged to handle so many beautiful felines.

I have been owned by a Siamese cat my entire life and my Mother told me that my first word was "cat".

As an exhibitor I have had many successes with my Siamese and Orientals, winning several Best Group 2 Exhibits in show.

With this sort of upbringing, my love for felines was inevitable and in 1999, at the age of 12 I was allowed to have my own cat; a Lilac Point Siamese spay and my show career started.

My involvement in cat shows has come a long way since that first show in October 1999.

In 2007 I registered my prefix 'Ayudha' and began breeding Siamese and now I have ventured out to breeding Siamese, Oriental, Devon Rex and even a Tonkinese litter.

In 2009 I realised that just being an Exhibitor was not enough for me and became a Steward.

Since then I have joined several Affiliate clubs and became part of numerous Show Committees in many different roles, experiencing Show Manager for the first time in 2014.

In 2015 I completed my Shorthair Judges training and commenced training for Groups 2 and 3.

In June 2021 achieved one of my lifelong dreams and became an All Breeds Judge.

I have a Bachelor of Arts and Diploma of Education from Macquarie University and work as a History/English teacher in High School, my other passion.

Conditions of Show Entry

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1 Aphrodite Longhair, Aphrodite Shorthair, Birman, Exotic Shorthair, Maine Coon, Nebelung, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian Turkish Angora & Turkish Van.
- Group 2 Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental Shorthair, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald, and Siamese
- Group 3 Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bombay, British Shorthair, Burmese (American), Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Longhair, La Perm Shorthair, Lykoi, Mandalay, Manx, Munchkin, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese, Toyger
- Group 4 Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 12 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion

ACF Award of Excellence maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay Cat in Groups 1, 2 & 3 in all rings. For a cat to be considered "of sufficient merit" the judge needs to certify "***I deem this cat to be of a standard of excellence of not less than 95%***".

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards

ONLY CATS NSW Inc MEMBERS ARE PERMITTED TO ENTER

"REGISTRATION PENDING" for Kittens under 4 months of age. Entries must include the "**REGISTRATION PENDING SHOW ENTRY FORM**" - see attached

KITTEN Each kitten exhibit must have had at least one (1) Feline 3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show. Documentary evidence i.e. a valid vaccination certificate from a Veterinarian must be produced to the veterinary officer. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of the exhibit concerned.

ADULT Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The vaccination certificate must indicate a valid vaccination being administered no more than 3 years prior to the show

A Veterinarian or Veterinarian Nurse will be present at all Cats NSW shows. All exhibits entered in show including those on exhibition must be examined by a Vet, Vet Nurse or an appointed Steward before being benched into the show cages.

SHOW RULES however it is highly recommended that all kittens have at least their 2nd vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show due to the recent outbreak of Feline Panleukopenia Virus (FPV) in New South Wales
