

Introducing our Judges

Sue Thomas - NSWCFCA



From early childhood I have had a lifelong association with various domestic cats and also a Manx.

My husband and I purchased our first Burmese in 1983. In 1985 we began showing, after purchasing two further neuter boys, both of whom were absolute family favourites with their wonderful temperaments.

Further kittens were bought in 1999, and later and so continued the showing.

I had made up my mind around this time that I would like to breed these gorgeous cats, however, this did not occur until 2006 when I purchased my first two breeding girls, and began breeding under the Sukimah prefix with some success on the show bench.

Stewarding followed, which I found to be a most rewarding experience, and one which enhanced my appreciation of other breeds. This in turn led me to studying for an all shorthair judge's license.

For some years now I have been and am the current secretary of The Burmese Cat Society of Asia, and previously I was the Treasurer for quite a few years.

For a period of time I was also the minute secretary of the Newcastle & Hunter Valley Cat Club Inc.

I am a current member of the NSW CFA Inc, and I am a member of both the Compliance/Education and Judges' Sub Committees.

In my private life I work as the fulltime practice manager of an accountancy practice.

Among some of my interests outside of breeding and showing cats, are car hill-climbing, reading, gardening, my family and simply spending time with our beautiful cats.

Shara McKay – Cats NSW Inc



I have been owned by a Siamese cat my entire life and my Mother told me that my first word was "cat". With this sort of upbringing, my love for felines was inevitable and in 1999, at the age of 12 I was allowed to have my own cat; a Lilac Point Siamese spay and my show career started. My involvement in cat shows has come a long way since that first show in October 1999.

In 2007 I registered my prefix 'Ayudha' and began breeding Siamese and now I have ventured out to breeding Siamese, Oriental, Devon Rex and even a Tonkinese litter. Conditions of Show Entry

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1** Aphrodite Longhair, Aphrodite Shorthair, Birman, Exotic Shorthair, Maine Coon, Nebelung, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian Turkish Angora & Turkish Van.
- Group 2** Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental Shorthair, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald, and Siamese
- Group 3** Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bombay, British Shorthair, Burmese (American), Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Longhair, La Perm Shorthair, Lykoi, Mandalay, Manx, Munchkin, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese, Toyger
- Group 4** Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 12 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion

ACF Award of Excellence maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay Cat in Groups 1, 2 & 3 in all rings. For a cat to be considered "of sufficient merit" the judge needs to certify "***I deem this cat to be of a standard of excellence of not less than 95%***".

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards

ONLY CATS NSW Inc MEMBERS ARE PERMITTED TO ENTER

"REGISTRATION PENDING" for Kittens under 4 months of age. Entries must include the "**REGISTRATION PENDING SHOW ENTRY FORM**" - see attached

KITTEN Each kitten exhibit must have had at least one (1) Feline 3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show.

Documentary evidence i.e. a valid vaccination certificate from a Veterinarian must be produced to the veterinary officer. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of the exhibit concerned.

ADULT Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The vaccination certificate must indicate a valid vaccination being administered no more than 3 years prior to the show

A Veterinarian or Veterinarian Nurse will be present at all Cats NSW shows. All exhibits entered in show including those on exhibition must be examined by a Vet, Vet Nurse or an appointed Steward before being benched into the show cages.

All Kitten/s must have at least one (1) vaccination and a vaccination certificate must be presented on the day of show as per CATS NSW INC. SHOW RULES however it is highly recommended that all kittens have at least their 2nd vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show due to the recent outbreak of Feline Panleukopenia Virus (FPV) in New South Wales
