INTRODUCING OUR JUDGES



KATHY CALHOUN (CFA USA)

Kathy is coming to us from Chicago, Illinois. Kathy embarked on her journey in the CFA Judging Program in 2007. Since then, her expertise has taken this CFA Allbreed judge across the globe, judging in numerous countries including the United States, Asia, Southeast Asia, Europe, Latin America, Canada, Russia, New Zealand, Japan, South Africa, and Australia.

Kathy's primary breeds are Maine Coons and Russian Blues, though she has also bred American Shorthairs, American Wirehairs, and Tonkinese. She has also worked with other breeds such as Burmilla, Lykoi, Persian, Oriental, Abyssinian, Chartreux, and Devon Rex.

Her CFA cattery, 5800 Dreams, has produced two National Winning American Wirehairs: GC, BW, NW 5800 Dreams Macy Gray (5th Best Kitten, 2001-2002) and GP, NW 5800 Dreams Marley of Kamage (16th Best Cat in Premiership, 2003-2004). Her success with Maine Coons is notable too. In the 2009-2010 season, GC, BW, NW 5800 Dreams Sunny Halo 1983 was CFA's Best of Breed Maine Coon and 3rd Best Cat, while in 2011-2012, GC, NW Trutails Aces High of 5800 Dreams was CFA's 15th Best Cat.

Kathy sits on CFA's Board of Directors, having served multiple terms as Treasurer (2000-2010 and re-elected in 2016). She also served as Midwest Regional Director (2012-2016) and chairs key committees like Diversity & Inclusion, Audit, and Budget. Her commitment to the feline community extends to her role as Treasurer for both the CFA Foundation and the Maine Coon Breed Council. She also contributes as the secretary for various clubs in the United States. Most recently of course, Kathy helped champion our causes in her capacity as the International Division Chair.

With Kathy's vast experience as a judge, breeder, and leader, she continues to significantly shape the world of cat breeding and showing.



ROBERT ZENDA (CFA USA)

ITsu-Kee-Ah-Kee Cattery (CFA # 3827); specialized in Silver Tabby American Shorthairs.

I organized the first CFA Club and show in Japan 1962-63. 1st pedigreed cat was a Seal Point Siamese purchased in 1959 in Tokyo, Japan and since then have bred and/or exhibited Abyssinians, American Shorthairs, British Shorthairs, Burmese, Colorpoint Shorthairs, Exotics, Persians, Siamese and Turkish Angoras. I began judging for another organization (ACFA) in 1968 and became a CFA Judge in 1995. I served on the CFA Judging Program Committee (Education/Training) and as the CFA International Division Liaison for Asia/Latin America 2006-2010. I served several terms as the CFA American Shorthair Breed Council Secretary and currently serve as Co-Chair, CFA International Division Committee, Asia (except China).

In addition to shows in the Continental USA, I have enjoyed the privilege of judging in the following countries: Australia, Austria, Belgium, Bermuda, Brazil, Bulgaria, Canada, China, England, Finland, France, Germany, Hong Kong, Indonesia, Israel, Italy, Japan, Kuwait, Malaysia, Netherlands, Philippines, Portugal, Russia, Singapore, Slovenia, South Korea, Sweden, Thailand and the Ukraine.

CARLOS LOPEZ (TICA Argentina)

I'm a TICA Approved Allbreed Judge/Ring & School Instructor living in Buenos Aires, Argentina. I also teach Mathematics and Statistics at the Economic College, University of Buenos Aires, with 28 years of teaching experience, including roles as Head of Maths and Secondary School. I was a founding member of Tango Cat Lovers Club (1998) and TICAdelPLATA (2008), served as TICA South American Regional Director (2011-2013) and have been a member of the Abyssinian Breed Committee since 2015. In 2017, I developed the Judging Committee proposal, approved by the TICA Board in 2018. Elected to the Judging Committee in 2018, I have been serving as TICA Judging Administrator since 2021.

I'm in the Cat Fancy for 30 years. The first pedigree cat I owned and showed was a black Persian male in 1993. In 1996, I began breeding British Shorthair cats under the prefix of "Pampa". I've been breeding Abyssinians since 2003. Over the years I have bred/exhibited many regional/international winners. I have enjoyed showing different breeds including a Somali, Bengals and an Exotic SH.

I am passionate about the Cat Fancy and TICA, enjoying breeding, showing, judging and putting on shows equally. Being a TICA judge is a big accomplishment. I entered the Judging Program in 1997 and became an International Allbreed Judge in 2005. Since then, I've judged extensively worldwide for TICA and other associations, including several TICA Annual Shows.

I'm so looking forward to coming back to Australia. See you all there!



GRANT LEIH (SACC South Africa)

Breeding and showing fell into my lap by accident in 2003, but soon became my passion that continues to this day.

My draw always veered towards a specific breed's personality rather than its aesthetics. Though this changed dramatically after training to become an all-breeds judge. Along this journey I developed an affiliation for the different and unusual.

As such my main focus has always been the LaPerm but I have also bred American Curl, Selkirk Rex, Cornish Rex, Scottish Fold.

I was a founder member of one of the largest and most successful breed groups that have run some of the largest shows in South Africa for a number of years. Including having 32 Sphynx, 14 LaPerms and over 20 Cornish Rex on one show, an achievement our committee is very proud of considering the small cat fancy in South Africa.

Shows are dedicated to the education and promotion of the Rex breeds as well as those who have mutations that affect the coat such as the Sphynx and Peterbald, but also with a strong drive for charity and the care & protection of all felines.

My journey towards becoming an all breeds judge began in 2006 and took 12½ years to complete. I have been involved in mentoring many new people to the cat fancy, as well having a lot of involved in tutoring new, young and upcoming judges.

- For each 4th placing in Top 5 in each Ring, 2 points
- For each 5th placing in Top 5 in each Ring, 1 point

In the event of a tied result, a countback of highest placed results will be used.

Conditions of Show Entry

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1 Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Nebelung, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian, Turkish Angora and Turkish Van.
- Group 2 Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental Shorthair, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald and Siamese.
- Group 3 Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bengal Longhair, Bombay, British Shorthair, British Longhair, Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Donskoy, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Shorthair, La Perm Shorthair, Lykoi, Mandalay, Manx, Munchkin, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese and Toyger
- Group 4 Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 10 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc however should such standard of points be not available the appropriate standard issued by Cats NSW is to be used.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion.

ACF Award of Excellence maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and in Groups 1, 2 and 3 in all rings. For a cat to be considered of sufficient merit the Judge needs to certify "I deem this cat to be of a standard of excellence of not less than 95%".

Group 4 is inclusive of Desexed Cat and Desexed Kittens. An Award of Merit maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Companion Neuter Cat and Companion Spay Cat in all rings. The exhibit must be placed in the Top 5 to be considered for this award.

Where the judge feels the quality of the exhibits merit such awards, ribbons and/or product will be awarded in each ring to the Top 5 Entire Cats, Top 5 Desexed Cats, Top 5 Kittens in Groups 1, 2 and 3, and Top 5 Companion Exhibits in Group 4.

A Pedigree Supreme Exhibit in Show in each ring will be awarded. A Supreme Companion Exhibit in Show will be awarded over all rings.

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards.

All Cats NSW Inc. Associate Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Associate Member Cat of the Year Awards.

Junior Handlers are eligible to compete for Junior Handlers of the Year awards in 5-12 years and 13-17 years categories.

Exhibits cannot be removed from the Show or from the cage designated by the Show personnel without the consent of the Show Manager. All exhibits must remain in the venue until the conclusion of the show at the advertised time.

All entries must be completed in full on the Cats NSW Show Entry and Benching Slip and the show entry summary sheet that form part of the show schedule. All completed entries must be forwarded to the address as nominated in the show schedule. The show committee reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation.

For each exhibit, a legible photocopy or electronic copy of its current Certificate of Registration must accompany the show entry. The Certificate of Registration must be in the name of the exhibitor and be issued by that person's governing body. Incomplete entries will be returned to the exhibitor. All exhibit's Certificates of Registration must be issued by the Governing Body to which the exhibitor is a member.

TO ENTER " REGISTRATION PENDING" for Kittens up to 4 months of age, entries must include the "REGISTRATION PENDING SHOW ENTRY FORM" - page 12

Female cats obviously in kitten will not be judged. No kitten under the age of 10 weeks will be allowed entry to the venue. The age of each exhibit will be calculated to be the actual age on the day of the show or the first day of a multi-day show

i. e. Kittens born on or before 5th July 2025, Cats born on or before 13th December 2024.

Lactating queens shall not be benched without their litters.

Amended rule

ADULT Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The certificate must indicate that the exhibit has received a valid vaccination 12 months from the last kitten vaccination then at least once every 3 years after this.

A Veterinarian or Veterinarian Nurse will be present at all Cats NSW shows. All exhibits entered in show including those on exhibition must be examined by a Vet, Vet Nurse or an appointed Steward before being benched into the show cages.

New rule

In the event the committee of Cats NSW becomes aware of a feline communicable illness following a cat show, an email notice advising all show exhibitors is to be sent within 24 hours, where practicable.
