# INTRODUCING OUR JUDGES



## ETUSKO HAMAYASU (CFA Japan)

### History of cats

1975 : Began caring for stray cats and grew up interacting with rescued cats kept by my aunt  
1983 : Started keeping Persian cats (Shaded Golden) and began participating in cat show as an exhibitor

1997 : Established Only Persian cattery PINGU

Bred Persians with 25 Grand, and 3 Distinguished Merit cats. Founded The Cat Fanciers' Association Inc. (CFA recognised club, Cat Walkers Japan)

2010 : Obtained a CFA Licensed Judge qualification,

2014 : Began breeding Siamese cats,

2023 : Began breeding American Shorthair cats,

2025 : Began breeding Exotic SH • LH cats

My home cats (as of 2026). In the year before last and last year, I bred Siamese and Exotic SH cats. All of the Siamese babies were male, so they were neutered, and I have kept two of them in my home.

As for the Exotic SH breeding, since the sire was a Persian, both long-haired and short-haired Exotic babies were born.

**MICHELLE McGRATH (NZCF)**

Breeds owned and/or bred include: Siamese/Oriental, Bengal, Sphynx, Persian and of course the beloved domestic. I have held a number of club positions including Shorthair Registrar, Breeds Standard Council and Breed representative, committee member.

I started judging cats in 2007 as a shorthair judge, and I qualified in May 2018 as an all breeds judge licensed with the New Zealand Cat Fancy.

I also judge horses, (for example miniature horse sections at the Royal Agricultural Show, and the Horse of the Year show).



**MARGARET SIM (CATS NSW)**

I have always had cats, firstly moggies then my father bred Seal Point Siamese. I met a pair of Burmese in the early 1970's and fell in total love with them, especially the Blue Burmese. When I settled down in Sydney I went in search of a Blue Burmese and ended up with a Lilac and Chocolate – they converted my partner Don to cats and in particular Burmese. He in turn converted me to Labrador Retrievers. We moved out of the city to Moss Vale – we had space and time so I commenced breeding and showing in 1987 under the prefix Bima. I breed all colours of Burmese and love them all – my favourites are blue, red and blue tortie.

This led to stewarding which gave me a love of many other breeds and in 1994 I commenced a judging course. I completed Group 2 in 1996, Group 3 in 1998 and in 2009 completed Group 1.

I have judged in most states of Australia as well as in New Zealand.

I have been involved in clubs – club secretary, committee member and am currently President of the Burmese Cat Society of Australasia. I have experience as show manager as well as working in card rooms and trophies, also lots of experience setting up and pulling down shows.

In my other life I am a registered nurse and midwife and currently work in a neonatal nursery. I have experience in management, aged care, education, women's health, aboriginal health, community health and paediatrics. My other interests are gardening, patchwork and quilting.



**ANNE HARVEY (TFA)**

Cats have always been part of Anne's family; however it was not until 1999 that she discovered the cat fancy. Beginning in the year 2000, Anne began breeding and showing Maine Coons. She was one of the first to introduce the breed to Queensland, and among the first handful of Maine Coon breeders in Australia at that time. Anne concentrated on health, temperament and quality in her breeding programme which produced some successful show winners and Cat of the Year winners during that time, but more importantly produced healthy well-balanced kittens who bring joy to their families. Although no longer breeding, Anne enjoys the companionship of her retired Maine Coons. Anne retired from work in 2015 which enables her to devote more time to the things she enjoys in life and to indulge her passion for travel. # Conditions of Show Entry

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1 Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Nebelung, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian, Turkish Angora and Turkish Van.
- Group 2 Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental Shorthair, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald and Siamese
- Group 3 Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bengal Longhair, Bombay, British Shorthair, British Longhair, Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Donskoy, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Shorthair, La Perm Shorthair, Lykoi, Mandalay, Manx, Munchkin, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese and Toyger
- Group 4 Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 10 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc however should such standard of points be not available the appropriate standard issued by Cats NSW is to be used.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion.

ACF Award of Excellence maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and in Groups 1, 2 and 3 in all rings. For a cat to be considered of sufficient merit the Judge needs to certify "I deem this cat to be of a standard of excellence of not less than 95%".

Group 4 is inclusive of Desexed Cat and Desexed Kittens. An Award of Merit maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Companion Neuter Cat and Companion Spay Cat in all rings. The exhibit must be placed in the Top 5 to be considered for this award.

Where the judge feels the quality of the exhibits merit such awards, ribbons and/or product will be awarded in each ring to the Top 5 Entire Cats, Top 5 Desexed Cats, Top 5 Kittens in Groups 1, 2 and 3, and Top 5 Companion Exhibits in Group 4.

A Pedigree Supreme Exhibit in Show in each ring will be awarded. A Supreme Companion Exhibit in Show will be awarded over all rings.

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards.

All Cats NSW Inc. Associate Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Associate Member Cat of the Year Awards.

Junior Handlers are eligible to compete for Junior Handlers of the Year awards in 5-12 years and 13-17 years categories.

Cats NSW Inc. representatives and officiating judges reserve the right without prejudice, to expel any exhibit from the show that appears to be in ill health or condition (including the presence of external parasites). Such decisions are final.

All entries must be completed in full on the Cats NSW Show Entry and Benching Slip and the show entry summary sheet that form part of the show schedule. All completed entries must be forwarded to the address as nominated in the show schedule. The show committee reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation.

For each exhibit, a legible photocopy or electronic copy of its current Certificate of Registration must accompany the show entry. The Certificate of Registration must be in the name of the exhibitor and be issued by that person's governing body. Incomplete entries will be returned to the exhibitor. All exhibit's Certificates of Registration must be issued by the Governing Body to which the exhibitor is a member.

**TO ENTER "REGISTRATION PENDING"** for Kittens up to 4 months of age, entries must include the **"REGISTRATION PENDING SHOW ENTRY FORM"** - page 13

Female cats obviously in kitten will not be judged. No kitten under the age of 10 weeks will be allowed entry to the venue. The age of each exhibit will be calculated to be the actual age on the day of the show or the first day of a multi-day show

**i.e. Kittens born on or before 17th January 2026, Cats born on or before 28th June 2025.**

Lactating queens shall not be benched without their litters.

**Amended rule**

**ADULT Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The certificate must indicate that the exhibit has received a valid vaccination 12 months from the last kitten vaccination then at least once every 3 years after this.**

A Veterinarian or Veterinarian Nurse will be present at all Cats NSW shows. All exhibits entered in show including those on exhibition must be examined by a Vet, Vet Nurse or an appointed Steward before being benched into the show cages.

**New rule**

**In the event the committee of Cats NSW becomes aware of a feline communicable illness following a cat show, an email notice advising all show exhibitors is to be sent within 24 hours, where practicable.**


