1. The show committee reserves the right to change any requirements or process relating to the show at any time and without consultation with exhibitors. Exhibitors will be advised if any requirements change.
2. Should the show need to be cancelled for any reason, entry fees will be refunded in full.

BENCHING AND SET UP

3. Vetting will be in line. Please bring with you your exhibit/s vaccination card.

4. Awards cards, certificates will be placed on cages as usual.
5. Prizes will be given out in accordance with advice from the Show Manager.

Tamworth & District Cat Club Entry requirements:

For each exhibit, a legible photocopy or electronic copy of its current Certificate of Registration must accompany the show entry. The Certificate of Registration must be in the name of the exhibitor and be issued by that person's governing body. Incomplete entries will be returned to the exhibitor. All exhibit's Certificates of Registration must be issued by the Governing Body to which the exhibitor is a member.

All entries must be completed in full on the Show Entry and Benching Slip and the show entry summary sheet that form part of this show schedule. The show committee reserves the right to reject any entry without explanation.

Tamworth Cat Club use line vet in - The Veterinarian shall disqualify any exhibit, which in their opinion is showing symptoms of any contagious disease or not be in show condition. The Vet's decision is final. If any exhibit is rejected because of an infectious or contagious disease they will disqualify all the other exhibits from the same cattery.

Awards and prizes: All such cards, trophies placed on cages are the responsibility of the exhibitor and the Club regrets that it is not possible to replace any that may subsequently disappear from unattended cages. The Show Committee reserves the right to vary the prize list if necessary.

Introducing our Judges

Ring 1 - All Groups Troy Willems FCCV



Born and raised in Queensland, I have always been an avid animal lover, with a particular passion for cats. My childhood was filled with the joy of raising an array of pets, from dogs and cats to guinea pigs, birds, and even tropical fish. Our family pets were always lovingly adopted, regardless of breed, and they became cherished members of our household.

In 2005, my life took an exciting turn when I stumbled upon an article about Bengal cats. The concept of these domesticated hybrids with Asian Leopard Cat lineage instantly captivated me. Following extensive research, I knew I had to introduce these magnificent felines into my life. In early 2006, I joined the FCCV as a breeder, operating under the Voodoocat prefix, and soon acquired my first breeding pair.

My journey into the world of cat shows began in late 2006, showcasing my first male. Although he was not suited for the show bench, I persevered and found success with my home-bred show cat, Voodoocat Khanji. Khanji possessed the perfect temperament and thoroughly enjoyed every aspect of the show circuit, eventually achieving the prestigious titles of CCCA Champion and Emerald Grand Champion.

Alongside my involvement as a breeder and exhibitor, I delved into the world of cat stewardship with the FCCV, where I had the privilege of working with esteemed domestic and international judges. An exciting opportunity to undertake the Group 2 & Group 3 in January 2017, and I relish the opportunity to evaluate short-haired cats at events nationwide. During 2023 I took my judging knowledge to the next level to become an All Breeds judge and have now successfully completed that last section.

Ring 2 - All Groups Chris Merritt FCCQ



I began my journey into the cat world in August 1975. My first passion was with Persians but before long, I was introduced to the beautiful British Shorthair and after some time, we embarked on the breeding of Exotic Shorthairs on an experimental program. This was very successful and thoroughly enjoyable.

As well as Persian, Exotic Shorthair and British Shorthair, we began breeding Burmese and then embarked on another experimental adventure to breed Mandalay. This was also a very successful endeavour which continued to fuel our passion. We finalised our program though in late 2023 but I miss them to this day. With my husband Terry, and with the support of our daughter Carolyn, we still breed British Shorthairs, many of whom have also had very successful show careers.

I became a Group 1 judge in 1986 and then qualified as an All-Breeds judge in 1992. Throughout these years, I have been very privileged to judge throughout Australia and New Zealand as well as overseas as a guest judge for CFA on many occasions.

Ring 3 – All Groups Phillipa Perkins NSWCFCA



I have been involved with the cat fancy since 1988.~ 35 years!! From when I first registered my breeding prefix “SINJIN” in 1988, under which I have exclusively bred Siamese & Orientals and much to my delight achieved numerous Breeder/Owner ~ Cat & Kitten of the Year awards over the years. I’m a founding & life member of “The Oriental Cat Club of NSW” (Est:1989) and have over the years of my involvement with this club, have held the positions of Vice President, Treasurer, and Show Manager/Show Secretary & currently hold the position of Club President. In July 2022, I was proudly presented with a “Honorary Membership” from the New Zealand Siamese Cat Association, which I had the privilege of judging for in Christchurch. NZ.

I became an approved steward in 1994, and then a NSWCFCA Companion Judge in 1999. In March 2017, I successfully completed with NSWCFCA ~ The All Shorthair Judges Training Course (Groups 2 & 3) and was granted my Full Shorthair Open Licence, and in August 2022, advanced to All Shorthair Tudor Judge. I am now an “Allbreeds Open Licence Judge” since end of 2023. My love & admiration for all felines gives me enormous pleasure judging and I am so looking forward to continuing this experience over the years to come. As we have some truly amazing pedigree cats on the show bench today. In my other life ~ What other life??The Cats Rule It.

Ring 4 – Split Wendy Hamilton - Longhair CatsNSW Inc



I have been a cat fancy member since a teenager and have bred Burmese, Birman, Siamese and Orientals. Importing a number of Birmans and Orientals to expand the gene pool and enhance my breeding programs, which span back some 40 years. I achieved numerous Best In Show awards with my Burmese and Birmans.

I became a CCCA judge in 1999 (G1), G2 in 2003 and finished to All Breed in 2010. I am a Life member and Patron of the Birman Cat Club of Australasia Inc after serving as President and Show Manager for over a decade. I have been an active Cat Fancy member, presented at many CCCA Judges Conferences, and Chaired a G1 Judges Training course for NSWCFCA, sat on Breed Standard Committees as well as two Association management committees and as a President.

In 2020 I transferred my license to ACF.

I consider myself fortunate to have judged around all of Australia and New Zealand as well as in France, Belgium and Netherlands. In this time, I have been privileged to handle so many beautiful felines.

Ring 4- Shorthair Fiona Cooper Cats NSW Inc



I bred Siamese, Orientals, Foreign Whites, Burmese, Devon Rex, Scottish Folds and even a litter of Abyssinians under the Fioric prefix from 1986 to the early 2000s.

I have been a regular exhibitor since 1985 and have exhibited in most parts of NSW and occasionally interstate.

My first Maine Coon litter was born in 1999, and I’ve bred these amazing felines since then under the Coolcoons prefix. I’ve imported several of these cats from the UK, Norway, the USA and quite a few from New Zealand.

I have enjoyed considerable show success with Coolcoons cats and kittens having won many Best Group 1 Exhibit and Supreme All Breeds Exhibit in Show awards as well as NSW CFA Kitten and Cat of the Year Awards.

I owned and/or bred Cat or Kitten of the Year in all 3 Groups with NSW CFA since I first began exhibiting and have owned and/or bred Cat or Kitten of the year in Group 1 for several years with Cats NSW, in 2024 one of our boys achieved the honour of being the highest point scoring exhibit ever in Cats NSW.

I gained my Group 3 judges’ licence in 1999, followed by Group 2 in 2003 and I completed my Group 1 training in 2008 and have enjoyed judging in most states of Australia, New Zealand and South Africa and transferred all those licences in 2013 to Cats NSW.

Conditions of Show Entry

Exhibits are divided into four groups for judging. These groups are:

- Group 1 Birman, Exotic, Maine Coon, Nebelung, Neva Masquerade, Norwegian Forest Cat, Persian, Ragdoll, Siberian Turkish Angora & Turkish Van.
- Group 2 Balinese, Foreign White Shorthair, Foreign White Longhair, Oriental, Oriental Longhair, Peterbald, and Siamese
- Group 3 Abyssinian, American Curl Longhair, American Curl Shorthair, American Shorthair, Australian Mist, Bengal, Bengal Longhair, Bombay, British Shorthair, British Longhair, Burmese, Burmilla Longhair, Burmilla Shorthair, Cornish Rex, Cymric, Devon Rex, Donskoy, Egyptian Mau, Japanese Bobtail Longhair, Japanese Bobtail Shorthair, Korat, La Perm Longhair, La Perm Shorthair, Lykoi, Mandalay, Manx, Munchkin, Ocicat, Pixiebob Longhair, Pixiebob Shorthair, Russian, Scottish Fold Longhair, Scottish Fold Shorthair, Scottish Longhair, Scottish Shorthair, Selkirk Rex Longhair, Selkirk Rex Shorthair, Singapura, Snowshoe, Somali, Sphynx, Tonkinese, Toyger
- Group 4 Desexed Companion Kittens and Desexed Companion Cats. Companion exhibits are permitted to show for the first time without classification and up to three times without being registered. All Companion exhibits must be at least 10 weeks of age and be desexed.

Exhibits will be judged under the standard of points of the Australian Cat Federation Inc however, should such standard of points not be available the appropriate standard issued by Cat NSW is to be used.

Groups 1, 2 and 3 are divided into 3 main classes. The classes are Entire Cat, Desexed Cat, and Kitten. Entire Male Cats, Entire Female Cats, Neuter Cats and Spay Cats will compete in open classes by group, breed and colour and maybe awarded challenges at the Judge's discretion

ACF Award of Excellence maybe awarded at the Judge's discretion to the best placed Male Cat, Female Cat, Neuter Cat and Spay Cat in Groups 1, 2 & 3 in all rings. For a cat to be considered of sufficient merit the judge needs to certify "I deem this cat to be of a standard of excellence of not less than 95%".

All Cats NSW Inc. Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Cat of The Year Awards.

All cats NSW Inc Associate Member's exhibits are eligible to compete for Associate Member Cat of the Year Awards.

Kittens under 4 months of age may be entered "REGISTRATION PENDING". Entries must include the "**REGISTRATION PENDING SHOW ENTRY FORM**" - see attached.

Kittens to be born on or before 16th May 2026

Cats to be born on or before 25th October 2025

KITTEN - Each kitten exhibit must have had at least one (1) Feline 3 vaccination not less than 14 days prior to the show. Documentary evidence i.e. a valid vaccination certificate from a Veterinarian must be produced to the veterinary officer. Failure to do so shall result in rejection of the exhibit concerned.

ADULT - Each adult exhibit must have a current vaccination certificate. The certificate must indicate that the exhibit has received a valid vaccination 12 months from the last kitten vaccination then at least once every 3 years after this.

In the event the committee of Cats NSW becomes aware of a feline communicable illness following a cat show, an email notice advising all show exhibitors is to be sent within 24 hours, where practicable.
